

- **Scholarship Process:**

1. The COMSO Empowering Women in Technology Scholarship committee will select scholarship recipients annually after review of application materials.
2. Awards will be made to **female high-school seniors**. Applicants enrolled full-time in baccalaureate programs in the next Fall term are the primary candidates for the awards. Scholarships will be awarded only for undergraduate study.
3. A completed application form with all supporting documentation must be submitted by **April 7th 2023**. Late applications will not be accepted.
4. Recipients will be notified by phone or mail no later than **May 5th, 2023**
5. Applicants must be a U.S. citizen and plan to attend college in the U.S. during the duration of the scholarship year.
6. Applicants must be in good standing and have a minimum of a 3.5 cumulative overall grade point average at their high school.
7. Applicants must submit the following documentation:
 - i. A high school transcript with a cumulative GPA
 - ii. 2 letters of recommendation (1 academic referral to support your ability in technology and 1 non-academic referral)
8. Interviews may be required of scholarship finalists.
9. Scholarship recipient selection(s) will be made to female candidates without regard to race, age, religion, political beliefs, employment status, or any other factor, which could constitute unfair or illegal discrimination.
10. Payment of the scholarship will go directly to the college where the student is enrolled. The Scholarship committee, based upon individual circumstances, can make exceptions to this policy.

Committee decisions are final.
